



BOARDING EXPERIENCE

What you should bring for your dog's boarding experience.

- Please bring food (include extra due to high energy expenditures or unanticipated extra night stay) in a sealed, waterproof container labeled with your pet's name and feeding instructions. If you need run-a-muk to provide food we will give your pet Science Diet dry food at \$1/per cup or Science Diet canned at \$3/per can.
- Please bring any veterinarian dispensed medications in the original prescription bottles, as well as any vitamins or supplements with instructions for proper administration. (*more than 3 medications or supplements may incur an additional charge at the manager's discretion*)
- If you bring any toys, beds, dishes or other items, you do so at your own risk as they could be destroyed by other guests. We will provide all the comfort and necessities for your dogs stay.

What to expect when your dog returns home.

- Since our canine guests are playing and running for much of the day outside on a variety of surfaces (gravel, dirt, asphalt), your dog may experience "tender feet". This is entirely normal and can be moderate or severe, depending on your dog's activity level and previous exposure to rough surfaces. While we will intervene with brief rest periods if we notice a dog's activity level is creating discomfort, you need to be aware this is totally normal for many dogs.

Boarding Experience

- Normal canine play often involves roughhousing in a way that doesn't happen at home and your pet may occasionally get nicked or scratched. Although all playtime is supervised, it is possible for minor scratches to go unnoticed, especially if your dog's behavior remains unchanged. Please understand we do our best to keep everyone safe while enjoying their freedom, and administer first aid when necessary.
- Constant mental and physical exercise and stimulation has a mellowing effect on dogs. On your dog's return home, don't be concerned if your dog seems to sleep more than usual. There is so much activity and action at **run-a-muk** that your dog often expends much more energy than when he is home laying around. Thus, it is not unusual for dogs to 'rest up' after a vacation with us. In no time, they will be back to their normal selves!
